

Arkas

Arkas (Dravakam) are the distilled extract, which contain the volatile constituents of the drugs used in the preparation. In the preparation of Arkas, the medicinal ingredients are cleaned, dried and make into coarse powder and soaked in required quantity of water and kept in the sunlight and moonlight for a whole day. The mixture is then distilled to collect the distillate which is packed immediately preventing any loss of volatile and aromatic compounds.

Arkas are more concentrate essence than other forms of medicines, are usually administered with required volume of boiled and cooled water or Arishtasavas. Generally arkas have the capacity to give the immediate relief as the absorption of medicinal radicals are done without digestion. The final product is a clear liquid with strong odour and taste of the ingredients used.



AJMADARK

(AVAMODHAKA DRAVAKAM)

INDICATION

Dysentery, intestinal colic, indigestion, worm troubles etc.

DOSAGE

5 to 25 ml. with kashayam, arishta or equal quantity of boiled and cooled water twice daily after food or as directed by the Physician.

PACKING

450 ml bottle.

BHAISARK

(POTHIN DRAVAKAM) (Ref:
Arkaprakasam)

INDICATION

Various rheumatic complaints such as paralysis, lumbago, sciatica, osteo - arthritis, stiffness of joints etc.

DOSAGE

1 5 to 25 ml. with Balarishta, Aswagandharishta or equal quantity of boiled and cooled water, twice daily after food or as directed by the Physician.

PACKING

450 ml bottle

SARIVARK

(SARASA PARILLA)
(Ref: Arkaprakasam)

INDICATION

Blood purifier and diuretic in action. Indicated in burning micturition, prickly heat, excessive thirst in summer etc. Controls body heat and give coolness.

DOSAGE

15 to 25 ml. with equal quantity of milk or boiled and cooled water twice daily, after food or as directed by the Physician.
